PW Director Thygesen stated he interpreted the code to state that the ditch would be the property owner's responsibility. He suggested that he would contact the City Attorney on the interpretation and contact JEO for a recommendation.

<u>Department Reports-</u> The Clerk reported that the City Attorney had advised him that the Secretary of State had replied back that annexation of part of the T-Bone trail would satisfy the requirements to annex Waspy's truck stop. The process would have to be started over from the beginning with new applications.

AYES; Griffith, Jacobsen, NAYS; Hemmingsen, Hocker ABSENT; Murray MOTION DIED DUE TO LACK OF MAJORITY.

<u>Public Hearing for FY 2017 Budget-</u>Hocker moved, Jacobsen seconded, to set the Public Hearing for the budget on March 14th at 5:30pm. ALL AYED.

<u>Resolution 16-8-</u> Jacobsen moved, Griffith seconded, to adopt this resolution appointing Rod Benton to Planning and Zoning Board. ROLL CALL: AYES; Jacobsen, Griffith, Hocker, Hemmingsen NAYS; none ABSENT; Murray RESOLUTION PASSED 4 to 0.

<u>Resolution 16-10-</u> Griffith moved, Jacobsen seconded, to adopt this resolution appointing Steve Stetzel to the Board of Adjustments. ROLL CALL: AYES; Griffith, Jacobsen, Hemmingsen, Hocker NAYS; none ABSENT; Murray RESOLUTION PASSED 4 to 0.

<u>Presentation of FY 2015 Audit-</u> Clerk Foran presented the Council with the results of the 2015 Audit. He went over changes of funds and operations from year over year. He answered any questions that the Council had. Hocker moved, Hemmingsen seconded, to accept the FY 2015 Audit report and instruct the Clerk to publish the notice. ALL AYED.

<u>Closed Session per IA Code 20.17-</u> Hocker moved, Hemmingsen seconded, to go into a Closed Session to discuss negotiations of a new agreement with the Union. AYES; Hocker,

Hemmingsen, Jacobsen, Griffith NAYS; none ABSENT; Murray MOTION PASSED 4 to 0. Closed session began and 6:46pm closed session ended at 7:55pm.

Open Session- Council voted to open session at 7:58pm.

Comments and Propositions-

<u>Mayor-</u> asked on the status of the Downtown revitalization project and the Market Street project. Clerk Foran explained that property owners were pledging to be on the project. The current number was around six. Apex, the company hired to handle the environmental testing, for the Market Street project is scheduled to take samples in February. Based on those results more work would be needed or the project would be ready to have ownership of the property change.
