New Business-

<u>Closed Session-</u> Murray moved, Hemmingsen seconded, to go into closed session to interview Craig Wanninger for the Public Works Director position ROLL CALL: AYES; Hemmingsen, Hocker, Griffith, Jacobsen, Murray MOTION PASSED 5 to 0. <u>Development Agreement-</u> Hocker moved, Griffith seconded, to put in a minimum valuation of \$7 million for the project, a 100% annual rebate, and a limit of \$375,000 for 5 years and to have the agreement sent to the Attorney to be readied for the Developer to review. <u>GPS Mapping for City-</u> Hocker moved, Jacobsen seconded to table this decision until farther along with the Wastewater project. ALL AYED.

<u>Stage lighting change order-</u> Murray moved, Hocker seconded, to approve the change order for the project at an additional \$400. ALL AYED.

<u>Cahoy contract-</u> Murray moved, Hocker seconded, to table the decision until there was a second bid. ALL AYED.

<u>Pool Works-</u> Murray moved, Jacobsen seconded, to approve the purchase of a new starter and motor box for pool, six light fixtures, a chemical controller for the large pool and a chemical controller for the baby pool, repair of the boiler heater, and to have furthers purchase request be run through the Parks and Recreation Board. <u>Resolution 16-20-</u> Hocker moved, Jacobsen seconded, to adopt the hiring of Ed Mahlstadt as Public Works Director. ROLL CALL: AYES; Hocker, Hemmingsen, Jacobsen NAYS; Griffith and Murray RESOLUTION PASSED 3 to 2

<u>Resolution 16-21-</u> Hocker moved, Jacobsen seconded, to adopt the resolution setting the compensation for the new Public Works Director at a salary of \$65,000 and 2 weeks of vacation along with all other benefits the City employees participate in. ROLL CALL: AYES; Hocker,

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Hemmingsen, Jacobsen, Murray NAYS; Griffith RESOLUTION PASSED 4 to 1. <u>Resolution 16-23-</u> Hocker moved, Griffith seconded, to approve the rescinding of Resolution 16-17 and approve the purchase of flow meter from GPM since they will install also. ROLL CALL: AYES; Hocker, Griffith, Murray, Jacobsen, Hemmingsen. RESOLUTION PASSED 5 to 0.
